### Get EdReady!- A Resource for NeSA-M, ACT, and Compass Preparation

EdReady, powered by NROC, is a free online math readiness and remediation resource for Nebraska students. Students can help themselves prepare for math assessments through pre-testing, personal goal-setting, instructional resources, and post-testing.

#### EdReady :

- Made available by the Nebraska ESU Coordinating Council and ESUs at no cost
- Test prep for ACT, Compass, and NeSA-M

#### The EdReady Student Experience:

- Students create a free account by clicking GET STARTED on the **ESUCC EdReady** homepage and adding their First Name, Last Name, school email address, and school or home zip code
- They will login to their school email account to verify their email address, and then go back to the ESUCC EdReady site and login and add their Goal Key given by their school
- Students will assess their readiness with a pretest
  - View results to see what is mastered and what needs work
- Build a study path utilizing the available instructional resources: Khan Academy, NASA eClips, Art of Problem Solving
  - Be ready for what you have chosen to do- students move through modules at their own pace

#### EdReady for Teachers and Administrators

- Accounts are requested through your local ESU
  - **Teachers and administrators should NOT create their own accounts**
- Data dashboard available for reports and monitoring of student progress
- Goals can be set for students
- Edit and revise assessments

#### EdReady Does Work!

- NeSA-M prep was piloted across Nebraska in 2014-15
- Number of students reaching “Meets” or “Exceeds” increased for those using EdReady vs. control group
